- Encourage all employees to be their own 'safety supervisor' and provide feedback on their work locations or activities.
- Continuously seek opportunities to improve the effectiveness of the HSE Management System

We engage our employees to support our HSE Management System by:

- Providing knowledge and awareness of the HoseCo HSE Management Policy, and emphasising the importance of adherence with its purpose, and compliance with HSE processes and instructions
- Fostering cooperation, participation and consultation with both employees and clients in the formation of plans to minimise the risk of harm to people, the environment or assets due to workplace hazards
- Empowering our people to stop work if they encounter practices or conditions that pose an imminent danger to themselves or others.
- Reporting all HSE incidents, injuries, as well as hazards that have the potential for injury or ill health, or potential situations that may have an adverse impact on the environment.
